Chamber Music Amici, the first resident company of the Richard E. Wildish Community Theater in Springfield, has been selling out concerts since 2009. It presents its third concert of the season in the Wildish Theater in Springfield at 7:30 pm, Monday, February 28. This concert features Beethoven's Trio in Eb for piano, violin, and cello, as well as Dvorak's Terzetto for two violins and viola. Amici musicians Steven Pologe, cello; Sharon Schuman, violin; and Victor Steinhardt, piano, will perform with guest musicians Matthew Fuller, principal second violin of the Eugene Symphony; violinist Fritz Gearhart of the Oregon String Quartet, playing viola; and Kathryn Lucktenberg, concertmaster of the Eugene Symphony. After the music there will be a party on stage, with desserts from Excelsior Inn and Brindiamo Catering.

In addition to the music, at this concert the five winners of the Amici Art Contest will be announced. Their paintings are currently on display at the Emerald Art Center, 500 Main Street, Springfield, and a free reception at the center, honoring Art Contest finalists, will take place before the concert at 5:00 pm. At the reception the People's Choice Award will be announced and children from the UO Community Music Institute will perform.
