**Chamber Music Amici: Concert 3, 7:30 pm, Monday, February 27, 2012**

Chamber Music Amici will present its third concert of the season, Monday, February 27, at 7:30 pm in the Wildish Theater in Springfield. This concert features Amici's newest Core Musician, Holland Phillips, who plays both violin and viola. She will perform on violin with Amici pianist Victor Steinhardt in Nielson's sonata in G for violin and piano. She will switch to viola for the rest of the concert: Mozart's Clarinet Trio, with Steinhardt and guest clarinetist Mike Anderson; and Dohnanyi's serenade for string trio, with Amici violinist Sharon Schuman and guest cellist Jason Duckles of the Amelia Trio. The concert ends with a cameo appearance by Amici violinist Pilar Brandshaw for two Beatles tunes, "Eleanor Rigby," and "When I'm 64."

Earlier in the evening, at 5:00 pm, 25 children from the UO Community Music Institute will perform free chamber music at the Emerald Art Center at 500 Main Street, where paintings from this year's Amici Art Contest finalists will be on display at the Art Contest reception. Everyone will have the opportunity to hear the next generation of chamber musicians perform and to vote on the People's Choice Award in the Art Contest. After the art and music, there will be just time enough to grab dinner at a local restaurant before the 7:30 pm Amici concert, where Art Contest Winners will be announced. As always, the concert lasts about an hour, without intermission, with a party on stage afterwards for audience and musicians.
