Chamber Music Amici presents its second concert of its fourth season at 7:30 pm, Monday, December 3, in the Wildish Theater in Springfield. The program features Max Bruch's String Quintet in A minor for two violins, two violas, and cello, performed by Amici violinists Sharon Schuman and Pilar Bradshaw, guest violist Fritz Gearhart, Amici violist Holland Phillips, and guest cellist Jed Barahal. Also on the program: a sonata for cello and piano by Portuguese composer Luiz Costa, performed by Barahal and Amici pianist Victor Steinhardt; and Mozart's Sonata in G for piano and violin, performed by Steinhardt and Bradshaw.

In the Wildish Theater, Amici concerts last about an hour, without intermission, with a party afterwards on stage. Tickets for Dec. 3 are \$20-\$25, or \$5 for students with vouchers, at 541-953-9204.

There are two other opportunities to hear this concert: at 1:00 pm, Friday, Nov 30, at Cascade Manor in Eugene, free; and at 7:00 pm, Dec. 1, at Marsh Anne Landing Winery in Oakland, Oregon, where Greg and Fran Cramer have created a cultural scene that includes music, gourmet wines and hors d'oeuvres. In addition to these regular Amici concerts, guest cellist Jed Barahal will also perform the complete Bach Suites for Solo Cello at two house concerts in Eugene (three at each concert), December 5 and 6 at 7:30 pm. These concerts offer a rare opportunity to hear all six Bach suites performed by a virtuoso cellist in an intimate setting. Barahal, who lives in Oporto, Portugal, has performed as concerto soloist, recitalist, and chamber musician in the U.S., Portugal, Spain, Germany, Italy, Rumania, and Turkey. A member of the Oficina Musical do Porto, which performs contemporary music in Portugal and abroad, Barahal also teaches at the Oporto College of Music and the Performing Arts.
