### **Narrative**

Chamber Music Amici will perform its second concert of the 2013-14 season at 7:30 pm, Monday, December 9, in the Wildish Theater in Springfield and at 7:00 pm, Saturday, December 7, at the MarshAnne Landing Winery in Oakland, Oregon. The program features the incomparable Brahms Clarinet Quintet, with guest clarinetist Louis DeMartino of the UO music faculty and guest violinist Kathryn Lucktenberg, also of the UO School of Music. They will join Amici violinist Sharon Schuman, Amici violist Holland Phillips, and Amici cellist Steven Pologe. The program also includes Milhaud's suite for violin, clarinet and piano, where Schuman and DeMartino will be joined by Amici pianist Victor Steinhardt. It opens Carl Nielsen's duo for two violins, where Phillips will switch to violin, performing from parts she created for her and for Lucktenberg, from the score for this composition, found only in Nielsen's "Complete Works."

The music lasts about an hour, without intermission, followed by a post-concert party with audience and musicians. Before the Marsh Anne Landing performance, which requires reservations (\$35) at 541-459-7998, concert goers will be able to taste wines and enjoy gourmet hors d'oeuvres.
