Chamber Music Amici Welcomes back Guest Artists Janice Tipton and Allan Vogel

Chamber Music Amici will present the fifth and final concert of our season on Monday, June 5 at 7:30 pm at the Shedd Institute for the Arts. The program will feature guest artists Janice Tipton, flute and Allan Vogel, oboe as well as Amici core musicians Victor Steinhardt, Pilar Bradshaw, Sharon Schuman, Jessica Lambert, and Steve Pologe.

The program includes a Boccherini Quintet for flute and strings, Schumann's Three Romances for oboe and piano, Copland's Duo for flute and piano, as well as the Dubois Quintet for violin, oboe, viola, cello, and piano.

This concert is part of a weeklong residency by Allan Vogel and Janice Tipton with Chamber Music Amici and includes free performances at public schools and community programs, a workshop for young players, and masterclasses at the University of Oregon.
